WHE REAS, under the Statute of Distribution of the State of South Carolina, the undersigned as husband is entitled to an undivided one-half interest in said lots and desires to transfer and assign all of his interest therein to the Grantees herein.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Clarence J. Reynolds of the County of Greenwood

ALL those pieces, parcels or lots of land being known and designated as Lots 315 and 316 on West Lake Circle as shown by a plat of Pine Forest, made by Madison H. Woodward, Engineer, and having the following metes and bounds:
