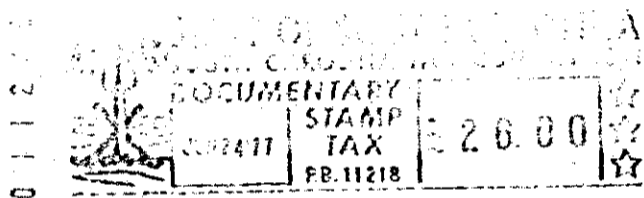
KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, BEVERLY C. HUDSON
