WHEREAS, Governors Square Associates, a partnership, placed certain restrictions on lots appearing on the plat entitled "Governors Square" made by W. R. Williams, dated October 17, 1975 recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in plat book 5 P page 8, and

WHEREAS, paragraph 4 of Section II provides as follows:

"4. No lot shall be recut without first obtaining the written permission of the Architectural Committee created under Article III hereof."

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the line between lots 8 & 9 Governors Court should be changed for the best use of said lots, and

WHEREAS, the Architectural Committee composed of Ronald E. Gregory and Doyle R. Peace have agreed that said line should be changed as shown on plat made by H. C. Clarkson, Jr., R.L.S. February 15, 1979. Now therefore, the undersigned Architectural Committee, hereby agree for the joint line between lots 8 & 9 be changed in accordance with said plat, copy of which is attached hereto and made a part of this agreement, and is to be recorded herewith.
