Williams of the State of South Carolina Laurens County planter of the one part and Henry Linderman of the County and State aforesaid Weaver of the other part Whereas in and by a certain grant bearing date the twenty first day of January one thousand seven hundred and Eighty five and in the ninth year of American Independance from and under the hand and seal of Benjamin Guerard Esq. Governor and Commander in Chief of the said State and the Great Seal of the said State for that purpose appointed did give and grant unto the said James M. Williams a plantation or tract of 640 acres of land Lying and being on Reedy River above the Antient Boundary line bounding on all sides on vacant land at the time it was Surveyed and hath such shape form and marks as appears by a plat to the said grant Annexed as in and by the said plat and grant duly Recorded in the Secretarys Office in the said State in Book C C C page 312 Reference thereunto had more fully appears Now this Indenture Witnesseth that the said James M.
