This Indenture made the Ninth day of February in the year  
of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and Eighty seven and in the  
Eleventh year of the Independence of the United States of America.

Between Robert Gilliland of Greenville County and State of South  
Carolina planter of the one part and William P. P. of the County and  
State aforesaid planter of the other part Whereas in and by a Certain  
Grant bearing date the fifth day of December one thousand seven hun-  
dred and Eighty five and in the tenth year of the Independence of  
the United States of America from and under the hand of His Excellen-  
cy William Moultrie Esquire Governor and Commander in Chief in and  
Over the State of South Carolina, and the great seal of the said State for  
that Purpose appointed and give and Grant unto Robert Gilliland a plan-  
tation or tract of Land containing two hundred and seventy one acres  
situate lying and being on the south Branches of the Golden Grove  
Creek and Waters of Saluda River, West of the Ancient Boundary and  
with such Shape form and marks as appears by a Plat thereof to the  
said Grant Annexed as in and by the said Plat and Grant duly Recorded  
in the Secretary's Office of the said State in Grant Book G C C page  
200 Reference thereto had may more fully appear. And this In-

denture Witnesseth that the said Robert Gilliland for and in con-  
sideration of the sum of Eighty pounds Sterling money to him in hand  
well and truly paid by the said William P. P. at and before the sealing  
and Delivery of these Presents the Receipt whereof is hereby acknow-  
ledged have Granted, Bargained, Sold, aliened, Remised, Released and  
Conveyed and these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell, alien, Remise Re-  
lease, convey, and confirm, unto the said William P. P. in his actual Pos-  
session now being by Virtue of a bargain and sale to him thereof made  
for one whole year and by force of the statute for transferring of uses into  
Possession and to his heirs and assigns, forever all that above menti-  
oned tract of land containing two hundred and seventy one acres be the  
same more or less, Together with all and singular the Houses, out-  
houses, Edifices, Buildings, Barns, Stables, Yards, Gardens, Orchards,  
Woods, underwoods, Timber, and Timber trees, meadows, Pastures, Ponds,  
Lakes, Fishings, Ways, Waters, Water courses, Paths, Passages, Liberties,  
Privileges, Profits, Hereditaments, Rights, members, and appertinances,  
whatssoever thereunto belonging or in anywise Appertaining and
