This Indenture Made the first day of February in the
Year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred and Eighty Seven
and in the Eleventh year of American Independence, Between
James Henderson of the State of South Carolina Ninety six
District and Spartanburgh County of the one part, and Daniel
Bush of the State and District aforesaid and Greenville County
of the other part, Whereas in and by a certain Grant bearing
Date the twenty first day of January in the year of our Lord
one thousand seven hundred and Eighty five from under the
Hand and seal of his Excellency Benjamin Guerard Esquire Govern-
or for the time being did give and grant unto James Henderson
a Tract of one hundred and seventy eight acres of Land, situate
in the District and State aforesaid on Branches of Saluda
River, Beginning on Daniel Bush's line on the bank of a branch
thence N 35° E six chain to a white oak twelve chain fifty
links to a stake, thence N 55° W eleven chain to a Pine corner,
thence N 35° E sixteen chain to a Black Jack Station, twenty
two chain to a hickory on a Branch running in thirty two chain
and fifty links to a Black Jack corner, thence S 70° E eight
chain to a Red oak Station, Nineteen chain to a white oak, twenty
one chain to a chestnut on the Bank of a Branch running in, thence
Down said Branch including the Meanders to the Beginning.

Witnesseth that the said James Henderson for and in the Con-
sideration of the sum of Twenty Pounds Sterling money to him
the said James Henderson in hand well and Truly paid, the Re-
ceipt whereof is hereby Acknowledged, he the said James Henderson
Hath Granted, Bargained, and sold, and by these presents doth grant
Bargain, and sell unto the said Daniel Bush his heirs and
