these presents the Receipt whereof is hereby Acknowledged and
that he is well Satisfied, and paid and have Granted, Bargained,
Sold, Aliened, Released, Conveyed, and confirmed unto the said
George Underwood his heirs and assigns and by these presents
Doth Grant, Bargain, Sell, alien, Release, convey and confirm unto
the said George Underwood his heirs and assigns a plantation
or tract of Three Hundred acres of land as aforesaid lying and
being as aforesaid, Together with all and singular, the Houses,
Gardens, Orchards, Timbers, Waters and Watercourses, Benefits, Profits,
Privileges, Advantages, Hereditaments and appurtenances therunto
belonging or in anywise Appertaining and the Reversion, and
Reversions, Remainder and Remainders, Rents, Issues, and Profits,
and of Every part and Parcel thereof and all the Estate, Right, Title,
Interest, use, Trust, Possession, Profit, Property, Benefit, Claim,
and Demand whatsoever of him the said John Watson of in to
or out of the same Premises and Every Parcel thereof and all Deeds,
and Evidences, Receipts, and Writings, whatsoever, Touching or
concerning the same Premises and Every part and parcel thereof
To have and to hold the said Three hundred acres of land with
Every the premises and appertinances therunto belonging
herein before Granted, Released and conveyed unto the said
George Underwood his heirs and assigns forever to the only proper
use and behoof of him the said George Underwood his heirs and
assigns and he the said John Watson doth hereby for himself his
heirs Executors Administrators and assigns Covenant, Promise,
and agree, to and with the said George Underwood his heirs

Executors, Administrators, and assigns, in the manner and form
Following (Viz) that he the said John Watson now is and until the
Execution of these presents shall stand seized of a good sure and per-
fect and Inalienable Estate of Inheritance in Fee simple, of and
in all the aforesaid land or Tract of Three Hundred acres with Rights
and appurtenances therunto belonging without any manner of
condition, Mortgage, Judgment, Execution, or Incumbrance whatso-
ever and also the said George Underwood his heirs and assigns
shall and may from time to time and at all times hereafter, have,
Hold, and Occupy Peaceably, and Quietly Possess, and Enjoy the said plan-
tation or tract of Three Hundred acres and Every part and parcel thereof
without any manner of Trouble, Hindrance, molestation and Denial
of him the said John Watson his heirs and assigns, and Lastly
he the said John Watson for himself, his heirs and assigns the said
Plantation or tract of Land above mentioned with the premises and
appurtenances unto the said George Underwood his heirs and
assigns against him the said John Watson his heirs assigns
and all and Every Other person or persons whatsoever shall Warrant
