 of Seven Hundred pounds Sterling money, to him in hand well and truly
 paid by the said William Himmelwright as and before the Sealing and
 Delivery of these presents, the Receipt whereof he doth hereby ack-
 nowledge, Have Granted, Bargained, Sold, aliened, Remised, Released,
 Conveyed and Confirmed, and by these presents doth Grant, Bargain,
 Sell, alien, Remise, Release, Convey and Confirm unto the said William
 Himmelwright in his actual possession, now being by Virtue of a bargain
 and sale to him thereof made, for one whole year, and by force of the Statute for
 transferring of uses into possession and to his heirs and assigns forever,
 all that plantation or tract of land containing six hundred and forty acres,
 being and lying in the County of Greenville on horse creek a branch of
 Ocoy River, bounded by vacant land on all sides at the time of the origi-
