


This Indenture made the twenty first of January in the year of our Lord one Thousand Seven hundred and Eighty Eight and in the twelfth Year of Independency of the United States of America, Between Isham Foster of the state of South Carolina and Ninety Six district of the one part and Thomas Bridges of the state and District aforesaid of the other part Whereas in and by a certain Grant bearing date the twenty first day of January one Thousand Seven hundred and Eighty five from under the hand of his Excellency Benjamin Guerard Esquire Governor for the time being did Give and Grant unto Isham Foster a tract of two hundred acres of land situate in the district of Ninety Six above the antient boundary line on both sides of Reedy River and hath such form and marks Buttings & Boundings as appears a plat to the said Grant annexed the said plat and Grant being duly Recorded in the Secretarys Office, Witnesseth that the said Isham Foster for and in consideration of the sum of fifty pounds current money to him the said Isham Foster in hand well and truly paid the Receipts whereof is Acknowledged he the said Isham Foster hath Granted Bargained and sold and by these presents doth Grant Bargain and sell unto the said Thomas Bridges his heirs and assigns all the above named two hundred acres of land, and also all Houses out Houses Buildings the Woods underwoods, Withes Commons and Commons of pasture ways Watercourses profits Commodities Advantages Hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever to the said tract of two hundred acres of land belonging or in any wise appertaining and the Reversion and Reversions Remainder and Remainders Rents Issues and profits of the said premises of every part and parcel thereof, and all the Estate Right Title Interest Claim and demand whatsoever of him the said Isham Foster of in and to the said tract of two hundred acres of land, and premises and every part thereof To have and to hold the said tract of two hundred acres of land, and all and singular

other the premises above mentioned and every part and parcel thereof with the appurtenances unto the said Thomas Bridges his heirs & assigns to the only proper use and behoof of the said Thomas Bridges his heirs and assigns forever and the said Isham Foster for himself his heirs the said tract of two hundred acres of land and premises and every part thereof against him and his heirs and against all and every person and persons whatsoever to the said Thomas Bridges his heirs and assigns, shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents In Witness whereof he the said Isham Foster hath hereunto set his hand and affixed his Seal the day and year first above written

This Indenture made this first day of March in the year of our Lord one Thousand Seven hundred and Eighty Eight and in the twelfth year of our Independency Between Matthias Sulser of the State of South Carolina and Ninety Six District and Greenville County of the one part, and John Gowen of the state and District aforesaid and Spartanburgh County of the other part Whereas in and by a certain Grant bearing date the fifteenth day of October one Thousand Seven hundred and Eighty four from under the hand of his Excellency Benjamin Guerard Esquire Governor for the time being and the Great Seal of this State for that purpose appointed did Give and Grant unto Thomas Davis a certain tract of four hundred acres of land situate and lying on both sides of South Tygar River all sides on vacant land when surveyed
