This Indenture made the Tenth day of July One
Thousand Seven hundred and Eighty Eight, and of the Independence
of the United States of America the thirteenth Between James
Mannen Gore of Chester County South Carolina of the one
part, and Thomas Lewis of the County of Greenville and state
aforesaid of the other part, Made full that the said James Man-
nen Gore for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred
Pounds to him in hand paid the Receipt whereof is hereby acknow-
ledged, hath bargained and sold, aliened and confirmed, and by these
presents, do bargain and sell, alien and confirm, unto the said Tho-
mas Lewis his heirs and assigns forever a certain tract of land
Containing two hundred acres (be the same more or less) situate

in the County of Greenville on Salady River including the Cedar Islands, granted
the said James Mannen Gore, by Grant bearing date the fourth day of
July One Thousand Seven hundred and Eighty five and Recorded in the
Secretarys office in Book 13/1313 Reference being thereunto had may
more fully appear. Together with all and singular the privileges and appur-
tenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, with the Rever-
sion and Reversions, Remainder and Remainders, and all and singular the
premises with the appurtenances and every part and parcel thereof:
To have and to hold the said Tract of land Containing two hundred acres
and all and singular the premises unto the said Thomas Lewis his heirs and
assigns, to the only proper use and behoof of him the said Thomas Lew-
is his heirs and assigns forever, and the said James Mannen Gore the
Land and premises before mentioned with the appurtenances, unto
the said Thomas Lewis his heirs and assigns against him the said
James Mannen Gore his heirs Executors Administrators and af-
