hundred and Eighty Nine, A deed of Conveyance for one hundred acres of
land from Daniel Kelley to William Flippo, acknowledged by the said
Daniel Kelley in open court and ordered to be recorded.

This Indenture Made this Ninth day of January in the Year of our
Lord Christ One Thousand seven hundred and Eighty Nine, and in the Thirteenth
year of the Independence of the United States of America. Between Daniel
Kelley of the County of Greenville and State of South Carolina of the one part
and William Flippo of the same County and State of the other part. Whereas
in and by a certain Grant bearing date the Twenty first day of January
anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and Eighty five and in the Ninth
year of the Independence of the United States of America from under the hand
of his Excellency Benjamin Querard Esquire Governor and Commander in
chief in and over the said State of South Carolina, and great seal of the
same, did give and grant unto the said Daniel Kelley a certain plan:
station or Tract of land containing one hundred acres situate, lying and being in
the District of Ninety six on the North side of the Saluda River and Middle
fork of said River, West of the old Indian Boundary and bounding as follo-
with. Beginning on a buck Eye Tree standing on the bank of the said middle
River, and running from thence South forty nine chains to a Hickory tree,
and from thence running South forty West twelve chains to a red oak
on the bank of the said River (Saluda) and from thence up the various
Meanders of both the said Rivers to the beginning. Now this Indenture
Witnesseth that the said Daniel Kelley for and in consideration of the sum
of Sixty Pounds Sterling Money to him the said Daniel Kelley in hand paid
by the said William Flippo at and before the sealing and delivering of
these Presents. The Receipt whereof he hereby doth acknowledge. Hath given
granted bargained and sold unto the aforesaid William Flippo all that before
mentioned tract or Parcel of land containing one hundred acres lying
and being in the County of Greenville on the North side of Saluda River
and middle fork thereof. Beginning on a buck Eye tree standing on the
bank of the said Middle River and running from thence South forty nine
chains to Hickory tree, and from thence running South forty West twelve
chains to a red oak on the bank of the said River Saluda and from
thence up the various Meanders of both the said Rivers to the beginning —
