44 South Carolina Greenville County May the Nineteenth One Thousand seven  
hundred and Eighty Nine, A deed of Conveyance for Two hundred acres of land  
from Nathaniel Miller to James Harrison produced in open court, being proved  
before Robert Maxwell Esquire, and ordered to be recorded.

This Indenture Made this third day of January in the Year of our Lord  
One Thousand seven hundred and Eighty Nine. Between Nathaniel  
Miller of the State of South Carolina and Greenville County of the one part  
and James Harrison of the said State and County of the other part.  
Witnesseth that the said Nathaniel Miller for and in Consideration  
of the sum of Twenty Pounds lawfull Sterling Money to him in hand well  
and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivering of these pre-  
sence by the said James Harrison the receipt whereof is hereby acknow-  
ledged by the said Nathaniel Miller and thereof and of and from every  
part and parcel thereof do acquit and discharge the said James Harri-  
son his heirs and assigns and for divers other good Causes and Consi-  
derations hereunto moving, Have Granted, Bargained, Sold aliened  
Enfeoffed and Confirmed and by these Presents do grant Bargain sell Enfeoff  
and Confirm, unto the said James Harrison his heirs and assigns forever  
all that part of Certain Tract of land Originally granted to the said Nathaniel  
Miller and signed by his Excellency Thomas Pinckney on the third day of March  
1788. Containing three hundred and thirty five acres lying and being in the  
County of Greenville and waters of Reedy River and Reaborn's Creek as by a  
plot annexed to the said Grant will more fully appear. Beginning on a  
Stake from thence S.W. 42° twenty eight Chains and thirty three links to a red  
Oak corner from thence N.W. 58° Sixty five Chains and fifty links to a  
Pine knot corner from thence N.C. 24° Seventeen Chains and fifty links to  
a white Oak corner, from thence S.E. 66° Sixteen Chains to pine Stake  
corner, from thence N.C. 24° along this line untill it intersect with and  
old line formerly made for James Whight, from thence S.E. 65° Thirty one  
Chains to a post Oak corner, from thence N.C. 25° five chains and twenty  
links to a pine Stake corner on the line made in the original Survey from  
thence S.E. 31° Thirty eight Chains to a pine Stake corner, and from thence  
to the begining containing by Estimation two hundred acres be the same  
more or less. Together with the Houses out Houses ways waters paths passages  
trees fences Basements Hereditaments and Appurtenances whatsoever to
