

68 South Carolina Greenville County August the seventeenth one thousand seven hundred and eighty nine, Give and release for ten acres of land from James M. Williams to John Linderman, acknowledged by the said James M. Williams in open court and ordered to be recorded.

This Indenture made the fourteenth day of August in the year of our Lord One Thousand Seven hundred and eighty nine, and in the fourteenth year of the Independence of the United States of America Between James M. Williams of Greenville County and State of South Carolina planter of the one part, and John Linderman of the county and State aforesaid planter of the other part. Whereas in and by a certain grant bearing date the fifth day of January One Thousand Seven hundred and eighty nine, and in the thirteenth year of the Independence of the United States of America, from and under the hand and seal of his Excellency Thomas Pinckney Esquire Governor and commander in chief in and over the said State, and the great seal of the said State for that purpose appointed, did give and grant unto the said James M. Williams a plantation or tract of two hundred acres of land and seventy six acres of land situate lying and being in the district of ninety six Greenville County South side of Reedy River, bounded South East by said James M. Williams land West by Duncan Camerons land, North East by Reedy River, all other sides by vacant land when surveyed, and both such Shape form and marks as appears by a plat thereof to the said grant annexed, as in and by the said plat and grant duly recorded in the Secretaries Office of the said State in book 999 of page 934 reference therunto being had may more fully appear. Now this Indenture Witnesseth, that the said James M. Williams for and in consideration of the sum of five pounds Sterling to him in hand well and truly paid by the said John Linderman at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, he the said James M. Williams hath bargained and sold and by these presents doth bargain and sell unto the said John Linderman ten acres of land being part of the above mentioned tract of two hundred and seventy six acres, laid out unto the said John Linderman as follows, beginning on a Sassafras which stands on the bank of said Reedy River, from thence running S 25 W 43. 50. to the corner on a post oak, from thence running N 50. E 50. 00 to the corner on maple which stands on the bank of said Reedy River, from thence bounding on the
