This Indenture made the 17th day of August and in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty nine, and the thirteenth year of American Independence, Between Charles Sullivant of the State of South Carolina and Ninety six district of the one part, and Samuel Neighbours of the said State and District of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Charles Sullivant for and in consideration of the sum of twenty pounds lawful Sterling money to him in hand paid by the said Samuel Neighbours at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof he the said Charles Sullivant doth hereby acknowledge
