Witnesseth that the said Charles Sullivan for and in consideration of the sum of twenty pounds lawful Sterling money taken in hand paid by the said Samuel Neighbours at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof he the said Charles Sullivan doth hereby acknowledge.
