of the other part, both of the State of South Carolina Ninety Six district Wit-
nesseth that the said William Gough for and in consideration of the sum of
Forty pounds Sterling to him in hand paid by William Stringer before enseal-
ing and delivering of these presents that the receipt whereof is fully acknow-
ledged, hath given granted and sold and by these presents doth give grant
bargain and sell alien and release convey and confirm unto the said William
Stringer and to his heirs and assigns forever a certain tract or parcel of land
lying and being in the State aforesaid and in Greenville County on both
sides of the ~~the~~ South fork of the Beaver dam Creek Chehore, butting &
