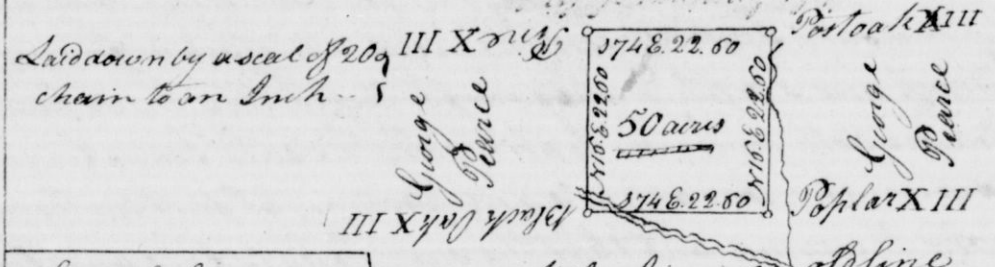

sand Seven hundred and eighty nine, A Deed of conveyance for two hundred acres of
land from Aaron Kemp and Joseph Dunigan to Isaac Greene, acknowledged
in open court and ordered to be recorded.

This Indenture made this thirteenth day of March in the year of our Lord
One Thousand Seven hundred and eighty nine, Between Aaron Kemp and
Joseph Dunigan, both of County of Greenville and State of South Carolina of the
one part, and Isaac Green of the County and State aforesaid of the other part,
Witnesseth that the said Aaron Kemp and Joseph Dunigan for and in consi-
deration of the sum of One hundred and fifty five pounds Sterling money to us
in hand paid, we the said Aaron Kemp and Joseph Dunigan hath bargain and
and sold and by these presents doth bargain and sell make over and convey
unto the said Isaac Green his heirs Executors and administrators and certain
tract or parcel of land containing two hundred acres situate lying and being in
Greenville County on a branch of Enoree River including the plantation
whereon Joseph Dunigan now lives, beginning at a red oak and running
