

South Carolina Greenville County August the Eighteenth One Thousand seven hundred and eighty nine, A Deed of conveyance for three hundred and one acres of land from Joseph O'Bannon to John Thomas Jun<sup>r</sup> produced in open court, being proved before Robert Nelson Esquire; and ordered to be recorded.

This Indenture made this Eighteenth day of August and in the year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred and eighty nine, Between Joseph O'Bannon of Wilton County and State of South Carolina of the one part, and John Thomas Jun<sup>r</sup> of Greenville County and State aforesaid of the other part, Witnesseth that the said Joseph O'Bannon for and in consideration of the sum of fifty pounds Sterling money to him the said Joseph O'Bannon in hand well and truly paid or secured to be paid at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged He the said Joseph O'Bannon doth grant, bargain, sold, aliened, released, conveyed and confirmed and by these presents doth grant, bargain, sell, alien, release, convey and confirm unto the said John Thomas his heirs and assigns for ever In his actual possession now being a certain tract or parcel of land containing by Estimation three hundred and one acres be the same more or less situate lying and being in Greenville County on both sides of Hamptons branch of the Beaver dam Creek waters of South Tigar River the said land being part of a tract of four hundred and eighty five acres of land granted to the said Joseph O'Bannon the day of October One thousand seven hundred and eighty four and hath such shape and marks as appears by a plat to the said grant annexed which said grant and plat being duly
