


This Indenture made the Eighteenth day of April One thousand Seven hundred & Eighty eight, and in the twentieth year of American Independence between Nathaniel Reed of the State of South Carolina Greenville County, and Joseph Reed of the State and County aforesaid. Whereas in and by certain grant bearing date the fifth day of June one thousand Seven hundred and Eighty Six and the great seal of the said State for that purpose appointed did give and grant unto Nathaniel Reed a plantation or tract of three hundred and fifty three acres of land on a creek called Rocky Creek in the State aforesaid and District of Ninety Six now called Greenville County recorded in the Secretarys Office for the said State in grant book M.M.M. page 128 the same Nathaniel had more fully appears. Now this Indenture Witnesseth, that the said Nathaniel Reed for and in consideration of fifty pounds to him in hand paid by the said Joseph Reed the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged. At the said Nathaniel Reed hath granted bargained sold remised released conveyed and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell remise release convey and confirm unto the said Joseph Reed his heirs and assigns three Hundred and fifty three acres being the said tract beginning at a red oak and runs thence North Seventy East to a red oak thence North twenty West to a stake, thence the parcel runs to the beginning containing three hundred and fifty three acres the same Together with all ~~and~~ singular trees wood underwood buildings orchards water water courses hereditaments and appurtenances as also the reversion and reversions, remainder and remainders rents issues and profits and every part and parcel thereof to have and to hold the said plantation or tract of ~~land~~ three Hundred and fifty three acres of land Together with all and singular the Hereditaments and appurtenances therunto belonging to the only proper use and behoof of the said Joseph Reed his heirs or assigns and the said Joseph Reed his heirs and assigns shall and may from time to time and at all times hereafter have hold use occupy and enjoy the said tract of three Hundred and fifty three acres of land without any manner of trouble hinderance molestation interruption or denial of this said Nathaniel Reed his heirs or assigns or of any other person or persons whatsoever. And lastly the said Nathaniel Reed for himself his heirs Executors Administrators or assigns of any other person or persons whatsoever the said tract of three Hundred and fifty three acres of land unto the said Joseph Reed his heirs Executors Administrators or assigns shall and will warrant and forever defend In Witness whereof the said Nath. Reed hath hereunto set his hand and affixed his seal the day and year first above written.
