The under written deed of conveyance from Robert Pince to James Young was proven before L. Atton Esquire by the oath of Thomas Norrys and recorded the sixteenth day of March 1790

This Indenture made the eighteenth day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand Seven hundred and eighty Nine between Robert Pince of Greenville County, and State of South Carolina of the one part & James Young of said county and State of the other part Witnesseth that for an in consideration of the sum of Ten Pounds Sterling in hand paid by the said Robert Pince by the said James Young before the signing and Delivery of these Presents hereof the Receipt hereof is hereby acknowledged the aforesaid Robert Pince hath hereby bargained sold and conveyed unto the above mentioned James Young a part of a certain tract of Land containing Two hundred Acres more or less bounded as follows, Beginning at a post Oak thence N^o 26 chain to a Red Oak thence W 20 chain to a Stake thence N^o 20 chain to a Stake thence E 23 chain 50 links to a Stake thence S 22 W 9 chain 50 link to a black Jack thence S 65 E 31 chain to a post Oak thence N^o 60 E 14 chain to a Red Oak thence S 41 W 35 chain 50 link to a post Oak, thence S 60 W 65 chain to a Stake thence N^o 13 W 10 chain to a Stake from thence to the beginning; together with all and singular the woods waters profits commodities hereditaments and appurtenances therunto belonging or in any wise appertaining To have and To hold the said land hereby Granted and Sold with their and every of their appurtenances unto the said James Young his heirs and assigns forever and the said Robert Pince for himself his heirs Ex. Adm^r and assigns the said hereby Granted premises with their appurtenances unto the said James Young his heirs and assigns against the claim or claims of every person or persons whatsoever shall and will warrant and for ever defend by these presents In Witness whereof the said Robert Pince hath hereunto set his hand and Seal the day and year first above written
