The following deed of Conveyance from William Lynch and Mary Lynch to Richard Brazzle was proven before Robert Nelson Esquire by the Oath of David Hall and Recorded this 25<sup>th</sup> March A<sup>d</sup> 1790

This Indenture made this first day of December one thousand seven hundred and eighty nine between William Lynch of the one part and Richard Brazzle of the other both of the State of South Carolina and Greenville County Witnesseth that the said William Lynch for and in consideration of the sum of fifty Pounds Sterling to him in hand paid by the said Richard Brazzle the Receipt whereof the William Lynch doth hereby acknowledge that the said William Lynch hath granted bargained sold Alien and confirm and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell Alien and confirm unto the said Richard Brazzle his heirs and assigns for ever all that plantation or tract of land containing fifty Acres be the same more or less situate in Ninety Six District on both sides of Greens creek of South Carolina River Granted to the said William Lynch by his Excellency William Moultrie Esq<sup>r</sup> on the fifth day of June one thousand seven hundred and eighty six beginning on the agreed Corner between Richard Brazzle and David Hall on a Red Oak on a branch thence W 88.10 to a Post Oak thence S 50 W 15 to a Post Oak thence S 15 to a white Oak thence E 92 to a Red Oak thence down a branch to the Creek thence up a branch North to the agreed corner on the branch
