to the Tenour and effect of every future such contract and agreement without
covin or fraude, that then and from thenceforth this present writing and
every Grant, matter and things herein contained shall cease and be void to
all intents and purposes whatsoever; any thing herein to the contrary notwithstanding;
and the Said John Henson for himself his Heirs Executors &
Administrators, doth covenant and agree to and with the Said John Dyche his
Executors and Administrators by these presents that till breach or non-performance
shall be made of the proviso, or condition aforesaid by the Said John Dyche
his Executors and Administrators shall or lawfully may have hold of and enjoy
all and singular the said land and premises with the appurtenances without any
any let or Interruption of or by him the Said John Henson his Executors
Administrators or assigns In Witness whereof I the Said John Dyche hath

ordain authorise constitute and appoint my well beloved and Trusty
friend John Lewis of the County and state aforesaid my True and
lawful Attorney for me and in my name and to my use to ask demand
Sue and Recover and Receive from a certain Joshua Harper of the State
of Virginia a debt due me by note of hand given to me by the Said
Joshua Harper bearing date the Twenty fifth day of March Seventeen
hundred and seventy nine payable the Twenty fifth day of December
following for two hundred and forty Pounds Virginia currency
