

At a Court began and held for may Term A.D. 1790 the following Deed
of Conveyance from Jeremiah Chandler to James M'Williams was pro-
duced in open Court and acknowledged by the Said Jeremiah Chandler
and ordered to be Recorded.

This Indenture made this seventeenth
day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and
Ninety; and of the Independence of the United States of America the
fourteenth between Jeremiah Chandler of the State of South Carolina
and Greenville County of the one part and James M'Williams of the
State and County aforesaid of the other part, Whereas in and by a cer-
tain Grant bearing date the sixth day of October one thousand seven
hundred and eighty eight from under the hand of his Excellency Thom-
as Pinckney Esquire Governor for the time being did give and Grant
unto Jeremiah Chandler a Tract of land containing Two hundred and thi-
fty five Acres, situate in Ninety six district on Brush Creek waters of
Ready River and hath such shape and marks as appears by a plat to
the said Grant annexed which said plat and Grant being duly Recorded
in the Secretary's Office Reference thereto being had may more fully
appear Witnesseth that the said Jeremiah Chandler for and in con-
sideration of sixty Pounds Sterling money of the said State to him the said Jeremiah
Chandler in hand well and Truly Paid by the said James M'Williams
the Receipt whereof the said Jeremiah Chandler doth hereby acknowledge;
he the the said Jeremiah Chandler hath Granted bargained and sold
and by these presents doth Grant bargain and sell unto the said James
M'Williams his heirs and assigns Sixty Acres of Land of the above Two
hundred and thirty five Acres of land (be the same more or less) taken off
from the upper end of the survey beginning on a post Oak Robert Hanner
corner thence S 13 W to a post oak corner on Brush Creek, thence S 51 E
across the creek to a Stake on the original line, thence N 71 W with the
original to the Stake corner thence N 63 E with the original line to
the beginning and binding on Hugh Roarks land and also all houses
out houses, buildings, trees, woods, under woods, Tithes, commoners,
and common of Pastures, ways, water-courses, profits, commodities
Advantages, hereditaments and appertinances whatsoever to the
said Tract of sixty acres of land above mentioned belonging or in any wise
appertaining and the Survey and Revisions Remainder and Remainders
Rents issues and profits of the said premises and of every part and parcel
thereof and all the estate, right, title, interest, claim, or demand what-
soever of him the said Jeremiah Chandler of in and to the said Tract of
sixty acres of land, be the same more or less and every part thereof To have
and to hold the said Tract of sixty acres of land, be the same more or less,
and all and singular other the premises above mentioned and every part
