

174 20th October one thousand Seven hundred and eighty Nine between Joseph Reed of the State aforesaid and County of Guilford of the one Part, and William Lacey of the said County of the other part witnesseth that the said Joseph Reed for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred pounds Lawful Sterling money to him in hand paid by the said William Lacey at and before the sealing and delivering of these presents the Receipt of which the said Joseph Reed doth hereby acknowledge and thereof and of and from every part and parcel thereof do acquit and discharge the said William Lacey his heirs and assigns and for divers other goods causes and considerations hereunto moving hath granted bargained sold Aliened Enfeoffed and confirmed and by these presents do grant bargain sell alien enfeoffed and confirm unto the said William Lacey his heirs and assigns for ever a certain Tract of land containing three hundred and fifty three acres originally Granted unto Nathaniel Reed and signed by his Excellency William Moultrie on the 5th day of June 1786 beginning on a Red Oak corner of said Tract of Land thence seventy degrees west seventy five chain Post oak corner thence North fifty eight chain and fifty links to Red oak corner thence North twenty degrees east fifty five chains to a Red Oak corner thence South twenty degrees east to the beginning including three hundred and fifty acres of land, together with all and singular the houses out houses ways waters, Paths Passages, Trees, fences easements hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever to the said parcel of land so discharged belonging or in any wise appertaining and the Reversion and Reversions Remainder and Remainders, Rents Issues and profits thereof and every part and parcel thereof and all the estate Right Title Interest claim and demand whatsoever both in law and equity of the said Joseph Reed of in and to the said Premises and of in and to every part and parcel thereof To have and to hold the said Tract of land and all and singular other the premises above mentioned with the appurtenances unto the said William Lacey his heirs and assigns to the only proper use and behoof of him the said William Lacey his heirs and assigns for ever and lastly the said Joseph Reed for himself and his heirs the said three hundred and fifty three acres of land and all and singular the premises above Granted with their appurtenances unto the said William Lacey and his heirs against all persons whatsoever shall and will warrant and for ever defend In Witness whereof the said Joseph Reed doth hereunto set his hand and Seal the day and year first above written sealed signed and delivered in presence of
