The following deed of conveyance from Nicholas Darnell to Valentine Thacker was Proven before Obadiah Hooper Esquire by the Oath of W^m H. Lacey & Recorded this 3th day of June A 1790.

This Indenture made this twenty ninth day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand Seven hundred and Ninety and in the fourteenth year of the sovereignty and Independancy of the united States of America between Nicholas Darnall of Pendleton County in the State of South Carolina Planter of the one part and Valentine Thacker of Greenville County and State aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of Seventy five Pounds Sterling in hand well and truly paid to the said Nicholas Darnall by the said Valentine Thacker before the sealing and delivery hereof the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged the aforesaid Nicholas Darnall hath hereby bargained sold and conveyed unto the before mentioned Valentine Thacker a certain Tract of land containing one hundred acres more or less situate in Greenville County on Austins Creek of Saluda River being part of a Tract of land Originally Granted unto the said Nicholas Darnall on the first day of January one thousand Seven hundred and eighty Seven by his Excellency William Moultrie Esquire cutting and bounding Southwardly by Land Surveyed by Maj^r Bowie and Northwardly by the said Nicholas Darnells land on a conditional line beginning at a Teo Oak corner and running from thence on a straight line till it crosses Austins Creek from thence on a line made by the aforesaid Parties to the Original line of the aforesaid Survey; Together with all and Singular the woods, waters, profits commodities hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining To have and to hold the said Tract of land hereby Granted and Sold with their and every of their appurtenances unto the said Valentine
