Page 46 Reference being thereunto had may more fully appear together
with all trees woods and under woods, water and water courses and appur-
tenances whatsoever to the said Tract belonging or in any wise appur-
taining and also all the Right Title Interest claim or demand of him
the said Uriah Bonner or his heirs the said Tract of Land containing seven
hundred and sixty nine acres and every Part and parcel thereof to have
and to hold all and singular the Premises above mentioned unto the S.
Isaac Morgan and his heirs forever and the said Uriah Bonner for himself
