The following deed of Conveyance from Jonathan Musick to ~~James~~ Wilson M^{rs} 187
Whinney was proven before Robert Nelson Esquire by the oath of John
Williams and Recorded this 30th day of June 1790.

This Indenture made this seventh day of February in the year of our
Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety and in the fourteenth year
of American Independence between Jonathan Musick of the one Part
and Wilson Whinney of the other Part both of the State of South Carolina
and Greenville County witnesseth that the said Jonathan Musick for
and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and fifty Pounds Sterling
to him in hand paid by the said Wilson Whinney at or before the en-
sealing and delivering of these Presents doth give grant bargain and
sell alien and release convey and confirm unto the said Wilson Whinney
and to his heirs and assigns forever a certain Piece Tract of Land situate
lying and being in the State and County aforesaid on the North fork of
Saluda River being part of a tract of land Granted unto the said Jonathan
Musick by letters Patent bearing date the fifth day of June one thousand
seven hundred and eighty six and in the tenth year of American Inde-
pendence being duly Recorded in the Secretary's Office in Grant book
L.L.L. Page 44 butting and bounding as follows Viz, Begining at
