The following deed of Conveyance from Robert Prince to Allen Smithson was proven before Obadiah Hooper Esquire by the Oaths of John Hooper and John Goodlett and Recorded this 6th day of July A D 1790.

This Indenture made this fifth day of September in the thirteenth year of American Independance and in the Year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty nine between Robert Prince of the State of South Carolina and County of Greenville of the one Part, and Allen Smithson of the County and State aforesaid of the other Part Witnesseth that the said Robert Prince for and in consideration of the Sum of Twenty Pounds Sterling to him in hand paid by the said Allen Smithson before the sealing and delivering of these presents the Receipt whereof the said Robt Prince doth hereby Acknowledge and therefore doth Release acquit and discharge the said Allen Smithson his heirs Ex^{ors} by these presents he the said Robt Prince hath Granted bargained sold Aliened Enfeoffed conveyed and confirmed and by these presents doth Grant bargain sell alien convey and confirm unto the said Allen Smithson and his heirs a certain piece parcel or Tract of Land situate in the County of Greenville and district on Ninety six on a branch of Bridge Creek of Saluda, beginning at a Hickory standing thence S 60° W 2 1/2 miles to a stake on Stanfords line thence with Stanfords line N 40-20-20 to a Red Oak on Stanfords other line west 38-50 to a Red Oak on Salmons line N 30 E 32 to Chesnut from thence to conditional Sower-wood corner between Allen and Mason Smithson and from thence to the Beginning and containing one hundred and fifty Acres more or less it being part of a Tract of Land granted to Robert Prince the seventh day of march one thousand seven hundred and eighty seven said Grant containing four thousand Acres and under the hand of his Excellency Thomas Pinckney Esquire and the great seal of the State for that purpose affixed and duly Recorded in the Secretarys Office.
