203 The following lease and Release from John Miller To William Poole was proven before Obadiah Hooper Esquire by the Oath of George Salmon Esquire and Recorded this 29th July 1790.

This Indenture made the fourth day of January and in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and Ninety between John Miller of Granville County Planter of the one part and William Poole of Spartanburgh County and State of South Carolina Iron Master of the other part Witnesseth that the said John Miller for and in consideration of the sum of five Shillings Sterling money to him in hand well and truly paid by the said William Poole at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged he the said John Miller hath bargained and sold and by these presents doth bargain and sell unto the said William Poole
