


I know all men by these presents that I William Hammonds of Greenville County & State of S^c Carolina for divers goods causes and considerations me therunto moving have made ordained and appointed and by these presents do make ordain and appoint Ambrose Fitzgerald of the County and State aforesaid my lawful Attorney with full power to ask demand sue and Recover and Receive the amount of a bond agreeable to the Tenor thereof given to Peter Hammonds by John Kings and now in the hands of William Bumpass and now my Right in Virtue of my Father Peter Hammonds will at his death and I do fully discharge the said Ambrose Fitzgerald to give Receipts or any other discharge Requisite to be done upon his Receipt thereof and to do any & all manner of things Touching the premises that I might or could do were I personally present In witness whereof I have herunto set my hand and Seal this 31st day of March 1790

The following Deed of Conveyance from James Jordan to John McElroy was produced in Open Court and acknowledged by the said James Jordan and Ordered to be Recorded and was done accordingly this third day of November 1790

This Indenture made the _____ day of one thousand seven hundred and ninety and of the Independance of the United States of America the fifteenth betwixt James Jordan of the State of South Carolina and County of Spartanburgh of the one part and John McElroy of the County of Greenville and State aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the said James Jordan for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and Fifty pounds Sterling to him in hand paid by the said John at and before the Sealing and deliver hereof the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged he the said James Jordan have Granted bargained and Sold Aliened and confirmed unto the said John McElroy his heirs and assigns for ever all that Plantation or Tract of Land containing Three hundred Acres (be the same more or less) Situate in the District of Ninety Six on the Ridge between Needy River and the little fork of Said River and hath such Shape form and marks Cuttings and bounding as may be seen by a plat thereof to the Original Grant annexed Granted to the said James Jordan on the First day of August 1785 Recorded in the Secretaries Office Grant book C C C Page 118 Reference being therunto had will more fully appear and also all Lands there
