acknowledge hath given Granted Bargained & Sold & by these presents doth free-
ly & absolutely give Grant Bargain sell & Confirm unto the s^t William Laffoon
his Heirs & assigns for ever a certain Tract or parcel of land containing one
hundred acres be the same more or less lying in the County of Greenville
& State afores^d On each side of the north fork of Saluda River Bounding
& Bounding as follows on Elias Earle's Land thence & Henry Hickam Woods
Land on two sides thence on Samuel Earle's Land & so forth it being part of
a tract of land Granted by His Excellency William Moultrie in the year
of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & eighty seven in April with all
