The following Deed of Conveyance from John Ford to William Cornelias was pro-
duced in Open Court and acknowledged by the said John Ford and Ordered to be Re-
corded - Recorded this 23rd day of December A.D. 1790.

This Indenture made this Twenty ninth day of October in the year of our Lord
one thousand seven hundred & ninety between John Ford Esq^t on the one part and
William Cornelias on the other part both of the state of South Carolina & Greenville
County witnesseth that the s^t John Ford for and in consideration of the sum of
Fifty pounds to him in hand paid at or before the sealing and delivering of these
presents the receipt & payment whereof is hereby fully acknowledged hath given
Granted & Sold & by these presents doth give Grant Bargain & Sell alien & release
convey and confirm unto the s^t W^m Cornelias his heirs & assigns for ever a certain Tract or
parcel of land situate lying & Being in the state of County afores^d on the north bank
of Saluda River butting & bounding as follows viz Beginning on a Ted Oak running
thence S 65 E 48-50 to a white oak thence N 49 E 17 to a Dogwood thence N 60 W 45 ch 75 to
a Ted Oak thence S 52 W to the begining containing eighty five acres Granted unto the afores^d
John Ford Esq^t by letters bearing date the sixth day of April one thousand Seven hundred
& Eighty nine, but whereas the above described Tract of land contains therein some land
Granted unto W^m Cornelias on the s^t & Thomas Farren on the s^t & W^t by letters patent
of an older date which land above mentioned is excepted in this deed there Re-
mains by estimation sixty acres then found vacant & the same more or less
& Being duly Recorded in Secretary's Office in Grant Book L 22 as by Refe-
rend thereto had may more fully & at large appear together with all woods
ways waters & water-courses buildings improvements & appurtenances
whatsoever unto the same belonging or in any wise respecting or appertain-
ing with the Rents Issues & profits thereof unto the said William Cornelias and
his heirs & assigns for ever free and clear from all Innuembre whatsover par-
cibly & quietly to profess & enjoy the same to have & to hold the above described
Tract or parcel of Land unto the proper use & behoof of him the s^t W^m Cornelias
his heirs & assigns forever & the s^t John Ford & Farren his wife their Heirs
Esq^t Adm^r the s^t Tract or parcel of land & appurtenances thereto belonging
