To all to whom it may concern that whereas Catherine Odear widow now an inhabitant of Greenville County & ninety six District and formerly binder have bound by the worshipful Court of Fairfield County two Children Benjamin & James unto Alexander Peader & that the sd Catherine having made sufficient provision for the support of herself and family & that the sd Alexander Peader being willing to resign his claim to sd Children above mentioned unto their Mother the sd Catherine being desirous to take care & support them the parties above mentioned do therefore enter into the following agreement, viz. that the sd Catherine Odear agrees to take the sd Children under ^{the} care and management & releasing the sd Alexander Peader from his obligation to them, the sd Alexander Peader hereby agree to resign & give up his Right and Claim in the services aforesd Children Benjamin & James unto the sd Catherine Odear to which agreement we each doth hereunto set our hands this twelfth day of May one thousand seven hundred and ninety, witness

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The following deed of conveyance from Joseph Langston to John Langston was produced in Open Court February Term 1791 and proven by the Oath of Joyce Carter & ordered to be Recorded which was done this 2nd March 1791

This Indenture made the twenty ninth day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety one & in the Fifteenth year of our Independency between Joseph Langston of the County of Greenville & State of S^t. Carolina of the one part and John Langston of the county and State aforesaid of the other part witnesseth that the sd Joseph Langston for and in consideration of the sum of five shillings Currant money by him the said John Langston in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath Granted Bargained and sold & by these presents doth Grant Bargain and sell unto the said John Langston his heirs and assigns one hundred acres of Land being part of my Grant for six hundred and forty acres under the hand of his Excellency William Morell Esq^r Governor for the time taken off the upper part including John Langstons Improvements Beginning at a corner Post Oak standing
