Inhabitant of Greenville County & ninety six District and formerly Lenoir have
bound by the worshipful Court of Fairfield County two Children Benjamin & James
unto Alexander Peadan & that the s^d Catherine having made sufficient provision
for the support of herself and Family & that the s^d Alexander Peadan being willing
to Resign his Claim to s^d Children above mentioned unto their Mother the s^d Catho-
rine being desirous to take Raise & Support them the parties above mentioned
do therefore enter into the following agreement Viz, that the s^d Catherine Odear
agrees to take the s^d Children under the care and management & releasing the s^d
Alexander Peadan from his Obligation to them, the s^d Alexander Peadan as hereby
agree to Resign & give up his Right and Claim in the services afores^d Children
Benjamin & James unto the s^d Catherine Odear to which agreement we each doth
hereunto set our hands this Twelfth day of May one thousand seven hundred

The following deed of conveyance from Joseph Langston to John Langston
was produced in Open Court February Term 1791 and proven by the oath of
Lyle Carter & Ordered to be Recorded which was done this 3rd March 1791

This Indenture made the Twenty ninth day of January in the year
of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety one & in the Fifteenth
year of our Independency between Joseph Langston of the County of
Greenville & State of S^c Carolina of the one part and John Langston of
the county and State aforesaid of the Other part Witnesseth that the s^d
Joseph Langston for and in consideration of the Sum of five shillings
Current Money by him the said John Langston in hand paid the Receipt
whereof is hereby Acknowledged hath Granted Bargained and sold & by
these presents doth Grant Bargain and sell unto the said John Langston
his heirs and assigns one hundred acres of Land being part of my Grant
for six hundred and forty acres under the hand of his Excellency William
Moultrie Esq^r Governor for the time Taken off the upper part Including
John Langstons Improvements Beginning at a Corner Post Oak Bearing
