The following deed of conveyance from Randolph Casey & Charity his wife to John Stanford Jun^r was produced in Court proven before Robt. Bellon Esq^r and ordered to be recorded, which was done this 5th March 1797.

This Indenture made this eighth day of December the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & ninety three in the fifteenth year of the Independence of the united States of America between Randolph Casey & Charity Casey his wife of the County of Greenville & state of S^t Carolina Planter of the one part & John Stanford Jun^r of the same County & state aforesaid Planter of the other part witnesseth that whereas in and by a certain Grant bearing date the fifth day of December one thousand seven hundred & eighty five under the hand of William C. Toultree Esq^r Governor & commander in chief in over the state aforesaid having the great seal of the state aforesaid therunto affixed did give & Grant unto the said Randolph Casey a tract of land containing two hundred acres situate lying & being in Greenville County in the District of Ninety six on the south bank of S^t Crag River joining vacant land Beginning at a Red Oak running South forty six & East forty four & to a stake thence South forty four & East forty four & to a stake thence North forty six & West forty four & to a stake thence North forty four & East forty four & to the begining containing the above
