 part witnesseth that the said David Humphreys for & in consideration  
 of the sum of Twenty five Pounds Sterling Money to him well & truly  
 paid by the said Thomas Whitman the receipt whereof the S<sup>r</sup> David  
 Humphreys doth hereby acknowledge to be fully satisfied & paid  
 he the S<sup>r</sup> David Humphreys hath Granted Bargained & Sold & by these
