



Granted, bargained, sold, Released, aliened, and confirmed & by these presents doth bargain sell alien Release and confirm unto the said John Birdsong him his heirs & assigns for ever all that Part of a certain Tract of Land Originally Granted unto the said Ambrose Blackburn & James Harrison and signed by his Excellency Thomas Pinckney on the fifth day of March one thousand seven hundred and eighty seven for four hundred & sixty seven acres lying in the aforesaid ninety six district of Greenville County and waters of Saluda River and Golden Grove creek as by a plat thereunto annexed will more fully appear all that part of the said Original Survey & Grant lying below a certain Maple and pine corner near the bank of Saluda River bounded Westward by Merieth Blackburn's land by John Birdsongs land on the southward and on the Eastward by Mapwell's land Goods land containing one hundred & fifty acres be the same more or less together with all & singular the houses out Houses ways waters Hereditaments appurtenances whatsoever unto the said Tract or parcel of Land described belonging or in any ways appertaining & the Reversion & Reversions, Remainder & Remainders Rents Issues & profits thereof & every part & parcel thereof To have and to hold the said Tract of Land & premises hereby Granted & sold with their & every of their appurtenances unto the said John Birdsong his heirs & assigns to his & their Only proper use and behoof absolutely & for ever and lastly the said Ambrose Blackburn & James Harrison doth hereby for themselves and heirs covenant and agree to and with the said John Birdsong his heirs or assigns against themselves and heirs and against every other claim under them shall & will warrant & for ever defend - - - meaning to convey such a title as was Obtained from the state as witnesses whereof the said Ambrose Blackburn & James Harrison doth hereunto set their hands & seals this day & year first above written.

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The following deed of conveyance from Daniel Kelley to John Jones was proven before Henry Wood Wood Esquire by the oath of William White and recorded this fourteenth day of March A.D. 1791

This indenture made the Twelfth day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & ninety & in the fourteenth year of the Independence of the united states of America between Dan<sup>l</sup>. Kelley of Greenville County & state of S<sup>c</sup>. Carolina of the one part & John Jones of the County & state afores<sup>d</sup>. of the other Part witnesses that the said Dan<sup>l</sup>. Kelley for & in consideration of the sum of Fifty Pounds Sterling to him the s<sup>d</sup>. Dan<sup>l</sup>. Kelley in hand paid before the sealing and delivering of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath Granted bargained and sold & conveyed & by these presents do confirm unto the s<sup>d</sup>. John Jones & his heirs for ever all that Tract or Plantation of Land containing two hundred Acres more or less being & lying on the dividing Ridge between N<sup>o</sup>. 7 & S<sup>o</sup>. Fork of Saluda Rivers having such courses & boundaries as the plat describes beginning at a station S<sup>c</sup>. Charles Land thence N<sup>o</sup>. 79 W to Fasters land & joining S<sup>c</sup>. Land to a black oak & thence N<sup>o</sup>. 75 W to a Chestnut & thence N<sup>o</sup>. 50 E to Stake thence S<sup>o</sup>. 7 E to post oak & thence N<sup>o</sup>. 50 E to white oak & thence S<sup>o</sup>. 62 E to stake thence on land laid out to H<sup>c</sup>. Wood to the beginning being part of two Tracts one Granted by his Excellency M<sup>rs</sup>. Moutrie in the year one thousand seven hundred & eighty six in June - - -
