The following deed of conveyance from William Rea to James Ewin was produced in Open Court and Acknowledged before Samuel Harrison Esquire and Ordered to be Recorded which was done this 31<sup>st</sup> day of March 1791 268

This Indenture made this seventh day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety between William Rea of South Carolina and Greenville County of the one part and James Ewin of the s<sup>d</sup> State & County of the other part Witnesseth that the said William Rea for and in consideration of the sum of thirty pounds lawful Sterling Money to him the s<sup>d</sup> William Rea in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the said James Ewin the Receipt whereof is hereby Acknowledged have Granted Bargained sold & Alien'd Released and Confirmed and by these presents do Grant Bargain sell and Confirm unto the said James Ewin his heirs and assigns for ever all that part or a certain Tract of Land Originally Granted unto John Dening and Signed by his Excellency William Moultrie on the first day of January 1787 lying in the said County of Greenville and on Horse Creek beginning on the N<sup>o</sup> side of Horse Creek and on a Maple from thence along a line of marked Trees North-  
 eastwardly to the Original line to a post Oak corner from thence along the said Original line North to the corner Post Oak from thence S 50<sup>th</sup> crossing Horse Creek to a station Black Oak & cornered from thence southwardly along a line of marked Trees to a hycory corner near a spring, from thence along a line of marked Trees Eastwardly to a black Oak corner from thence along a line of marked Trees crossing Horse Creek to a white Oak corner from thence down Horse Creek with its Meander to the beginning together with all and singular the Trees waters heridaments Rights members and appurtenances whatsoever to the said Tract of Land and premises
