and Ninety one Between John Sims of Ninety six District and Greenville
County of the one part and John Smith of the said District and County of the other Part
Witnesseth that the said John Sims for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty Pounds
Pound Sterling Money to him well and truly in hand paid by the said John Smith at
and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents the Receipt whereof is hereby fully
acknowledged has Granted Bargained sold aliened Released and confirmed and by
these Presents do bargain sell alien Release and confirm unto the said John Smith his
heirs and assigns for ever all that Part of a certain Tract of Land Originally Granted
unto John Winn Junr and Signed by his Excellency Benj. Gerard lying and being in Green-
ville County and on Reedy and Reedy fork of Reedy River Containing Three Hundred
Acres as by a plat thereunto annexed will fully appear all that part of the said Original
Survey and Grant Beginning on a post oak thence N.E. 24° Twenty five chain Cross-
ing Reedy River to the West Bank from thence N.W. 50° Twenty four chain and
fifty links to a maple corner on the River Bank from thence S.W. 32° by a line of
marked Trees to a stake corner on the line of the original Survey containing one
hundred acres be the same more or less together with all and singular the Trees waters
Hereditaments Rights members & appurtenances whatsoever to the said parcel or
Tract of Land hereby Bargained and Sold Belonging or in any wise Appertaining
and the Reversion and Averions Rents Taxes & profits thereof to have & to hold the
said Tract or parcel of Land and premises hereby Bargained and sold with their and every
of their appurtenances unto the said John Smith his heirs & assigns and to his Land
their Only proper use and behoof absolutely and forever and lastly the said John Sims
doth for himself and his heirs hereby Covenant and agree to and with the said John
Smith that the said Tract of Land as above described unto the said John Smith his heirs
and assigns against all and every person & persons whatsoever shall & will warrant
