 South Carolina.

This Indenture made the Twentieth day of  
 February in the year of our Lord one thousand seven  
 hundred and ninety one and in the fourteenth year of  
 the Sovereignty & Independence of America between  
 William Turnbough of the County of District of the s<sup>d</sup>.  
 District and state of the one part and George Mitchell of the s<sup>d</sup>.  
 District and state of the other part Witnesseth  
 that the s<sup>d</sup>. William Turnbough for & in consideration of  
 the sum of fifty pounds Sterling Money of the s<sup>d</sup>. State  
 to him in hand paid by the s<sup>d</sup>. George Mitchell his heirs  
 & <sup>or</sup> Assigns at or before the Delivery and sealing  
 of these presents the Receipt whereof he the s<sup>d</sup>. William  
 Turnbough doth acknowledge himself fully satisfied  
 contented and Paid and of every Part and parcel thereof  
 doth fully acquit separate and discharge him the s<sup>d</sup>.
