to George Gough was produced in Open Court and acknow-

This Indenture made the thirteenth day of Decem-  
-ber and in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred  
and ninety between John Childers of Greenville County  
and state of S<sup>c</sup> Carolina Scatter of the one part and George  
Gough of the County aforesaid of the other Part Witnesseth  
that the said John Childers for & in consideration of the  
sum of four pounds thirteen Shillings and four pence  
sterling Money to him the s<sup>r</sup> John Childers in hand  
well and truly paid by the s<sup>r</sup> George Gough the Receipt  
whereof is hereby acknowledged he the s<sup>r</sup> John Childers  
hath granted bargained sold aliened Released conveyed  
and confirmed and by these Presents doth Grant bargain  
sell, alien Release convey and confirm unto the s<sup>r</sup> George  
Gough his heirs and assigns for ever in his Actual Possession  
now being a certain Tract or parcel of land containing  
by estimation twenty Acres be the same more or less  
situate lying and being in the County aforesaid on the  
ridge between Cygar River and Childers's Beaver Dam  
Creek of said River running as followeth, Beginning on a
