

13 The following deed of Conveyance from Samuel Adams to Joseph Reed was proven before James Harrison Esquire produced in Open Court July Term 1791 and Ordered to be recorded, which was done this 1st day of August 1791
State of S. Carolina. This Indenture made the fourth day of February one thousand seven hundred and Ninety between Samuel Adams of the state aforesaid and County of the one part and Joseph Reed of the S. State and Greenville County of the other part Witnesseth the s. Sam. Adams for & in consideration of the sum of Eighty pounds lawful Sterling Money to him in hand paid by the said Joseph Reed at & before the sealing & delivery of these presents the 1st of which the s. Sam. Adams doth hereby acknowledge and thereof & of & from every part and parcel thereof do acquit and discharge the s. Joseph Reed his heirs & assigns & for divers other good causes and considerations hereunto moving have granted bargained sold aliened Enfeoffed & confirmed and by these presents do Grant bargain sell alien Enfeoff and confirm unto the said Joseph Reed his heirs and assigns for ever all of a certain Tract of land containing three hundred Acres Originally Granted unto Robert Thim and signed by his Kinsman William Moultrie on the first day of August one thousand seven hundred and Eighty five beginning on a post Oak & thence thence N. 55^o W. 63 chains & 24 links to red oak corner thence S. 35^o W. 47 chains & 75 links to pine stake corner thence S. 55^o E. 63 chains & Twenty four links to stake thence to beginning Including three hundred acres with said plantation where the s. Joseph Reed now lives Together with all and singular the houses out houses ways waters paths passages Trees fences Easements hereditaments and Appurtenances whats ever to the said parcel of land so discharged belonging or in any wise Appertaining and the Reversion & Reversions, Remainder & Remainders
