The following Deed of Conveyance from Thomas Lewis  
To Solomon Littleton was proven before Robert Hafner Esq.  
by the oath of Vincent Davis presented in Open Court July 9<sup>th</sup>  
and Ordered to be Recorded which was done this 23<sup>d</sup> day of Augt 1791

This Indenture made the sixth day of May one thousand  
seven hundred and Ninety one Between Thomas Lewis  
of the first part and Solomon Littleton of the County of Green-  
ville and state of S. Carolina of the second part witnesseth  
that for and in consideration of the sum of Forty pounds  
Sterling paid by the said Solomon Littleton the receipt  
whereof the said Thomas Lewis doth hereby acknowledge  
he the said Thomas Lewis hath Bargained and sold alien-  
ed and confirmed, and by these presents hath bargained  
and sold alien and confirm unto the said Solomon Littleton  
his heirs and assigns for ever all that plantation or Tract of  
Land containing one hundred and fifty acres situate in the  
county of Greenville on Saluda River Including the Cedar  
Island being part of a Tract of Land of two hundred acres  
originally granted to James Gore as a Bounty on the fourth  
day of July 1785 and Recorded in the Secretary's Office in  
Grant Book B.B.B.B. page 228 Begining at the mouth of a  
small Creek running, thence up the said Creek to the original  
line, thence along the s<sup>d</sup> line to corner of said Grant thence  
on said line to the river thence up the river as represented  
by the Grant Together with all woods under woods Timber  
and Timber Trees, ways, waters, commons, commons of pas-  
tures commodities and Appartenances whatsoever hereto
