The following Deed of conveyance from William Young to John Young being proven before George Salmon Esq^r was presented in Open Court February Term 1792 and ordered to be Recorded which was done this 24th Feb^y 1792

This Indenture made the Twenty third day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety and in the fifteenth year of the Independance of the united States of America Between William Young of the state of S^c Carolina and Greenville County of the one part & John Young Jun^r of the state aforesaid & County of Spartanburgh of the other Part Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of one Spanish Milled Dollar to the said William Young in hand paid by the S^r John Young Jun^r the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged he the said William Young hath Granted Bargained & sold aliened Enfeoffed Conveyed & confirmed
