

111 The following Deed of Conveyance from Benjamin Smith to Robert Langford being proven before Robert Maxwell Esq<sup>r</sup> was presented in Open Court February Term 1792 and ordered to be recorded which was done this 25<sup>th</sup> February 1793

This Indenture made this second day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & ninety one & in the sixteenth year of the Independence of the Independence of the United States of America Between Benjamin Smith & Annartha Smith of the County of Greenville and State of South Carolina of the one part and Robert Langford of the County of Greenville and State afores<sup>d</sup> of the other part Witnesseth that the said Benjamin Smith & Annartha his wife for and in consideration of the sum of sixty pounds lawful Money to them in hand paid at and before the sealing & delivering of these presents the Receipt hereof is hereby acknowledged & the said Benjamin Smith & Annartha his wife hath given granted Bargained sold aliened confirmed released and confirmed and by these presents do give Grant bargain sell alien lease release and confirm unto the said Robert Langford his heirs and assigns one certain piece or parcel of land situate lying and being in Ninety six District on the North side of Saluda River containing one hundred acres of Land more or less it being a part of Six hundred & Eight Acres of Land Originally Granted to Edwin Smith by his Excellency William Moultrie Governor of the State aforesaid Granted & dated the fifth 5<sup>th</sup> day June one thousand seven hundred & Eighty six
