The following deed of Conveyance from Allin Smithson to  
William Few being proven in open Court May Term 1792 by  
the oath of George Tubb was Ordered to be recorded which  
was done this 1<sup>st</sup> day of July 1792.

This Indenture made this twentieth day of August  
In the fifth year of American Independance & in the  
year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & ninety one  
Between Allin Smithson of the State of South Carolina &  
County of Greenville of the one part & William Few & William  
Few of the County of State aforesaid of the other part Wit-  
nesse that the said Allin Smithson for & in conside-  
ration of the sum of Twenty pounds Sterling to him in  
hand paid by the S<sup>r</sup> William Few before the sealing and  
delivering of these presents, the receipt whereof the S<sup>r</sup> Allin  
Smithson doth hereby acknowledge & therefore doth release  
Acquit & discharge the said William Few his heirs Ex<sup>ors</sup>  
& Adm<sup>rs</sup> by these presents he the S<sup>r</sup> Allin Smithson granted  
Bargained sold aliened conveyed & Confirmed and by these  
presents doth grant bargain sell alien Convey & Confir-  
unto the S<sup>r</sup> William Few and his heirs a certain piece parcel  
or Tract of land situate in the County of Greenville and  
District of Ninety six on a branch of Bridge Creek of Saluda
