This indenture made this 10th day of January
 in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred &
 Ninety Two and of the Independance of the united States
 of America the sixteenth year between Martin Webb
 of the County of Greenville & State of S^c Carolina of
 the one part, & Samuel Parker Sen^r of the County & State
 aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the said
 Martin Webb for & in consideration of the sum of one
 hundred pounds Sterling Money to him in hand
 well & truly paid by the s^d Samuel Parker the receipt
 whereof the s^d Martin Webb doth hereby acknowledge
 he the s^d Martin Webb hath granted bargained & sold
 aliened & confirmed & by these presents doth grant
 bargain & sell alien & confirm unto the s^d Samuel
 Parker his heirs & assigns for ever, a certain Tract
 or parcel of land containing one hundred acres, be
 the same More or less, situate in the County & State
 aforesaid on Saluda River which s^d Tract of one
