

courses meadows profits & Emoluments thereunto Belonging or
in any wise appertaining to the S^d lands also the rents & tithes
& issues thereof to have & to hold the aforesaid Granted
premises unto the said William Tane his heirs &c^{es} Adm^r or
assigns for ever to their only proper use & behoof & that the S^d
George Russell his heirs &c^{es} Adm^r &c^{es} doth Covenant & agree
with the said William Tane his heirs & assigns that he shall
at all times hereafter peaceably & Quietly hold Occupy possess
& Enjoy the S^d Tract of one hundred & seventeen acres be the same
more or less lying & being as afores^d from all bargains sales
Mortgages Judgments Rights dowers & from all persons claiming
by from or under him & that the S^d George Russell his heirs &c^{es}
will warrant & for ever defend the S^d one hundred & seventeen acres
of land more or less unto the S^d William Tane his heirs &c^{es} from
all and every other person or persons whatsoever that may lay
any claim or title therto by from or under him In witness
