

The following Deed of conveyance from Wilson McKinney & Eliza
beth his wife to William Plumlee being proven before Larkin
Tarrant Esquire was produced in Court May Term 1798 and
Ordered to be recorded which was done this 30th May 1798
This Indenture made this fourteenth day of October in
the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & ninety one
and in the fifteenth year of American Independence between
Wilson McKinney on the one part & William Plumlee on
the other both of the State of South Carolina & Greenville
County Witnesseth that the said Wilson McKinney for his
consideration of the sum of one hundred & fifty Pounds Ster-
ling to him in hand paid by the said William Plumlee at or
before the sealing & delivering of these presents the receipt &
payment whereof is hereby fully acknowledged hath given
granted sold & by this presents doth give grant bargain
& sell alien & release convey confirm unto the said William
Plumlee and to his heirs & assigns for ever a certain piece
Tract or parcel of land situate lying & being in the County
aforesaid and on the North fork of Saluda river being
part of a Tract of land Granted unto Jonathan Musick by
letters patent bearing date the fifth day of June one thousand
seven hundred & eighty six & by the S^r Jonathan Musick
transferred unto the aforesaid Wilson McKinney by a Deed
of Conveyance bearing date the tenth day of February one
thousand seven hundred & ninety & recorded in the County
aforesaid in Book B page 187 as by reference therunto had
