

Harrison and signed by his Excellency Thomas Pinckney on the second day of June one thousand seven hundred Ninety two for one hundred Ninety one acres all that part of said Tract of land beginning on a Gum Station for a branch thence N 70° to a post oak Williams Corner thence S E 70° & Ch. 150 links to a post oak Hudsons Corner, thence S E 30° Eleven chains & 50 links to a post oak Hudsons corner, thence N E 60° seven chain to a post oak Hudsons corner thence S E 30° ten chain to a Lightwood Stake Corner (Hudsons) from thence on Hudsons line S E 70° so far as will Intersect with a line Originally made for Richard Langster, now called Russell's land thence South Westward with the said line so far as will Intersect with a certain line Originally made for William Hogan now called Sinkens's land from thence N W 66° with the said Hogans line to a stake Corner the Original Corner from thence S W 21° on the said Original line to a large branch from thence up the said Branch with the meanders to the beginning Gum Station as by the plat annexed to said Original Grant will appear Bounded South South Westward by Frederick Croft's land granted to William Gilliam South Eastward by lands granted to William Hogan, and Richard Langster Northwardly by lands Granted to the said Hudson also one other Tract or parcel of land lying in the aforesaid County, and on Rocky Creek, the waters of Needy River Originally Granted unto the said James Harrison Signed by Governor Charles Pinckney on the 5th of March 1772 for four hundred & sixty three acres all that part of said Tract of land Viz, Beginning on Ezekel Henderson's Corner a poplar thence N W 50° fifty Chain to a stake Corner thence N W 60° with the Original line to and Oak Longs Corner thence N W 80° to a Black Jack Corner thence S W 20° Ch. to a stake Corner on Dewalls line thence S E. 50° Twenty Eight Chain to a stake on Dewalls line thence on with the Original line Crossing Rocky Creek to a stake Corner thence A nineteen Chain to a stake Corner thence S E. 40° 10 Ch. to a red Oak Corner, thence N E 25° thirty four Chain to a persimmon Corner thence N W 50 to the beginning Poplar Corner as by a plat to the said Grant will appear containing by Estimation (in the whole) Two hundred & fifty acres be the same more or less Together with all singular the Trees waters hereditaments
